# The Breakdown

## Annual Membership Dues

- Non-refundable \$2,100 payable upon enrollment covers regular annual membership (September - June).
- Siblings and SMMUSD employees receive 25% off the membership dues.

SMMUSD Employee Dues	\$1,575 per child
Additional Sibling Dues	\$1,575 per child

## Additional Membership Options:

### Drop in Membership

We are excited to introduce Drop in Days should a day-by-day basis better serve your child and family. Drop in Days can be purchased in bundles of 12 for \$500. These days are non-refundable and not prorated. Once the 12<sup>th</sup> day has been used, another 12 can be purchased for \$500. Drop in Membership does not include holidays, pupil free days or school closure days.

## Payment Options

Should you prefer to not pay 100% of your membership upfront (September 2019), BGCM has outlined payment options. For families utilizing a payment plan, we require a credit card to be kept on file and be charged with timely payments. Should you wish to make reoccurring monthly payments, **please note that membership is not month to month and cannot be prorated based on usage.**
