Internship Details

One of the primary functions of the Boys & Girls Club of Malibu Wellness Center is to provide training to the next generation of mental health professionals. The Wellness Center offers a comprehensive training program for therapists working towards their LMFT, LCSW, or PhD/PsyD license in the state of California.

The foundation of the Wellness Center's treatment philosophy includes CBT, Solution Focused, Family Systems and Play and Art Therapy. Experiences will also include working with our Social Support Services Dept. as well collaborating with our agency partners.

Requirements

- One-year internship commitment
- We start interviewing in August for a September start date. Or in December for a January start date
- Caseload: 5 -10 client hours
- Adults /Family/Group Counseling/Children
- Administrative tasks- notes, treatment plans and diagnosis
- Group supervision / training on Fridays from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
- Two full days a week commitment 9-3pm
- In-services throughout the year
- Two school or community presentations
- Supervision 1 hour a week unless more than 5 clients, then it will be group
- Monthly workshops are mandatory
